Roy V. Weiss, 83, of Deep River, died October 3, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

He was a steward of the land and enjoyed operating his Oliver brand tractors. Roy was quiet-natured and liked all his cats, dogs, and cows. He was a caretaker for his mother when her health began to fail.

Survivors include one brother, Laverne (Ann) Weiss of Independence, Missouri; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Leland Weiss in 1955.
