Mrs. Anna Craig Brown Died Early This Morning

Mrs. Anna Katherine Craig Brown, wife of Solomon Brown of 715 1/2 Spring Street, passed away at 12:30 a. m. today in a local hospital where she had been a patient for 18 days. She was 78 years old and had been in failing health for several years.

Funeral services have been tentatively set for 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon from the Smith Funeral Home.

Anna Katherine (Craig) Goode Brown, was an older sister to Eva Pearl Craig Renfrow and an aunt to Edith Renfrow Smith and her siblings. She was born 6 June 1867, and in 1887 married Edward Goode in Grinnell; William E. Goode was their son. After Ed Goode's 1901 death, she remained a widow until 1920, when she married Solomon Brown. She died 24 Jan 1946 after a hospital stay of two weeks.
