Edith A. Sternfeld of Santa Barbara died Sept. 5 at Goleta Valley

Hospital. She was 91.

Miss Sternfeld was born in Chicago Sept. 26, 1898. She attended school in Chicago and graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Northwestern University.

Miss Sternfeld worked at the Layton School of Art in Milwaukee, Wis., for five years. She worked at Grinnell College in Grinnell, Iowa, for 37 years. She was a professor emerita of art when she retired in 1967.

She was a Phi Beta Kappa, Chi Omega and member of the Santa Barbara Museum of Art. She also belonged to the Santa Barbara Art Association, the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History, the Santa Barbara Symphony Association, the American Association of University Women, National Audubon Society, National Trust for Historic Preservation, United Nations Association, Common Cause, American Association of Retired Persons and the Alumni Association of Northwestern University.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Wesley Chapel of the First Methodist Church, with the Rev. Robert B. Weirbach of the First United Methodist Church officiating.
