
## 6 H-R 12-12-2019 Mary W. Comerford



Mary W. Comerford, 76, of Pompano Beach, Florida, and formerly of Grinnell, Iowa, died on Monday, December 2, 2019, at her home.

In 1972, they moved to Miami, Florida, where Mary completed her education with a BA in Anthropology at Florida International University and a Master's Degree in Public Health from the University of Miami where she worked at the School of Medicine for 40 years doing dermatological and AIDS research, writing articles, performing statistical analyses, and teaching statistics.

Mary was a voracious reader with a large library of books, especially murder mysteries and scientific books. She enjoyed raising her three children, playing games with her three grandchildren and going to their activities, traveling to many U.S. cities, to England, to Ireland and cruising to Caribbean Islands. She was also a University of Miami fan and attended many baseball and football games. Also, she was a life-long Chicago Cubs fan attending many games at Wrigley Field and

other National League cities.
