Hugges La Interment will occur in Hazelwood cemetery in charge of the local Masonio lodge.



Sterrett was black. Born in PA, he moved to Ohio where he joined the army during the Civil Wa, finishing as 1st Lt. in Company S, 40th Infantry Regiment of US Colored Troops. After the war settled in Tama. Later lived in Grinnell where he died in 1901.
