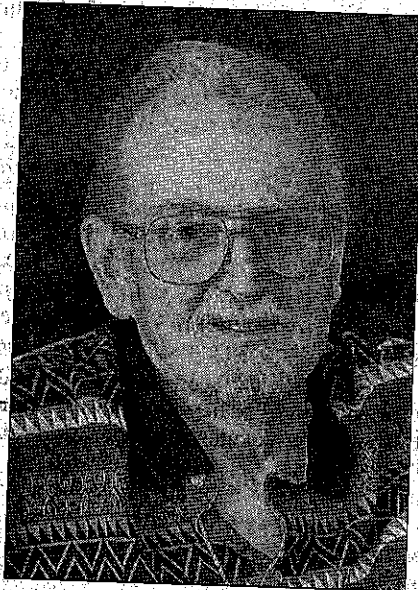


William Harold 'Bill' Kann
