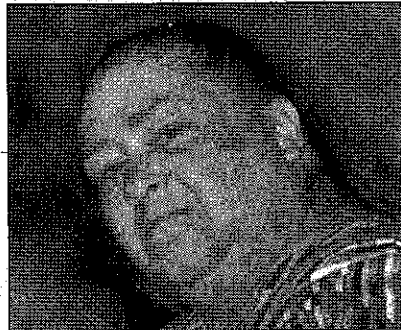


## Tammy Doreen Pittman
