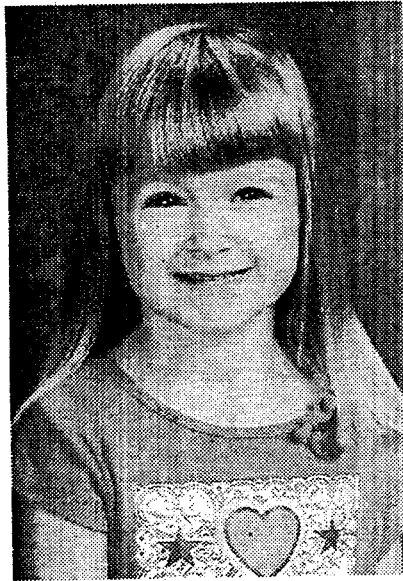
play.
