Pauline attended the Webster Grade School in Pella for all grades except the sixth when she went Lincoln Grade School.

On Nov. 19, 1931, she was united in marriage with Louis De Wild at Knoxville, and to this union one son, Howard Wayne. Following their marriage Pauline and Louis lived on a farm south of Pella on the Washboard road.

Surviving is her son, Howard De Wild, a retired History teacher, and his wife, Linda of Allison; three grandchildren and three greatgrandchildren: Dr. Louis John De Wild, an Anesthesiologist, and his wife, Rebekah and their son, Henry Louis De Wild of Des Moines; Juliana Irene De Wild, a Registered Nurse of Coralville; Malina Jen, a Registered Nurse, and her husband, Jeremy Withrow and their two sons, Austin Chase and Christian Charles Withrow also of Coralville.
