Paul G. Ferneau, 91, of Vancouver, Wash., formerly of Grinnell, died April 8, 2006, in Vancouver.

A memorial service was held April 13 at Hillcrest Church of the Nazarene in Vancouver with inurnment on April 17 at Salmon Creek Methodist Cemetery.

He was born May 19, 1913, in Grinnell, the son of Bessie and Lee Ferneau. He served in the United States Navy during World War II as a Petty Officer Second Class.
