a special gift from God. She loved to work in her gardens, make floral arrangements and decorate their home. She also loved to help her children and grandchildren wallpaper, paint, decorate or landscape in their yards. Deloris had the idea to start a gardening club in Sully. She invited people she knew that shared her interest and the Sully Garden Thyme Club was formed in the summer of '98. Deloris's strong faith brought her through many trials including the drowning accident of her son, Curtis, age 7, in 1968, a skydiving accident of her son, Larry, age 25, in 1995, and her cancer which started in 2018.
