

Dr. S. C. Buck Passes Away At Age of 80 Years

B. J. Ricker of Berkeley, Calif., sends The Herald-Register a clipping from the Berkeley Daily Gazette of May 29 announcing the death in Oakland on the evening of Monday, May 27, of Dr. S. C. Buck, early Grinnell college graduate in 1888 and former Grinnell physician. Dr. Buck was the son of Professor S. J. Buck, one of the pioneer members of the college faculty who served the institution for many years. Death was due to a heart attack and came at the advanced age of 80 years.

Dr. Buck retired 10 years ago and after an interesting medical career which began in Iowa after his graduation from Rush Medical college. He practiced in Grinnell for nearly 25 years and during World War I entered the army, serving with the medical corps. After the war he served on the examining board of the veterans administration in San Francisco.

Dr. Buck is survived by his widow, Mrs. Olive T. Buck and by two daughters, Mrs. Frank Pierce of Berkeley and Mrs. Frederick A. Metcalf of Louisiana. He also leaves two grandchildren, Janet and Richard Pearce.

Funeral services were held on Friday.
