He also co-owned a tiling machine and purchased Victor Oil company.

Hard work, honesty and customer service were the qualities that described Don as a human being and business owner. For many years he enjoyed traveling with Susie and fishing trips to Canada with friends. After hearetired, he enjoyed taking care of his yard and small garden, listening to music, completing parts of his coin collection, playing cards, and especially going NO BUSHINGS OF W

to breakfast with his buddies.

Don's biggest love in life was the town of Victor and its people. Everywhere he traveled he compared to Victor. Such as, "There is no traffic in Victor." Or, "You don't have to wait hours for the cable to be fixed in Victor." He was greatly honored when asked to be a Grand Marshall at the Victor Quasquicentennial celebration, Don was a member of the Victor Methodist

Church and the Victor Volunteer Fire Department.
