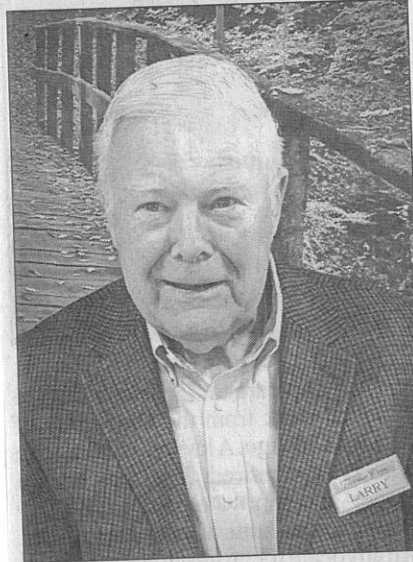


Larry Norman King
