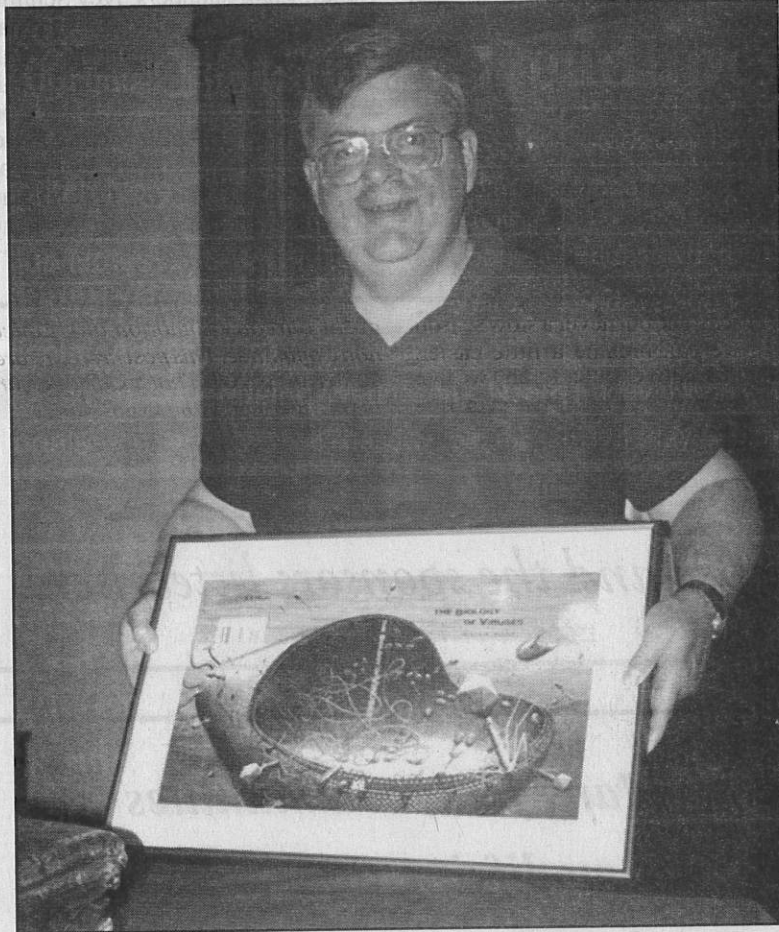


Bruce A. Voyles ^{GHR}

Bruce A. Voyles passed away on May 24, 2022, surrounded by his family in the Grinnell Medical Center. Bruce was a Professor of Biology at Grinnell College from 1977 until his retirement in 2011. He is remembered as a teacher, a research mentor, one of the creators of the Biological Chemistry major, and the author of the textbook *The Biology of Viruses*. Outside of work, Bruce enjoyed cooking, reading, and music. He was also responsible for one of the first Victorian houses in Grinnell redone in the "painted lady" style at 1312 Broad Street.

Bruce is survived by his wife Martha, children Paul and Erin, and grandchildren Simon, Isaac, Sam, and Ben.
