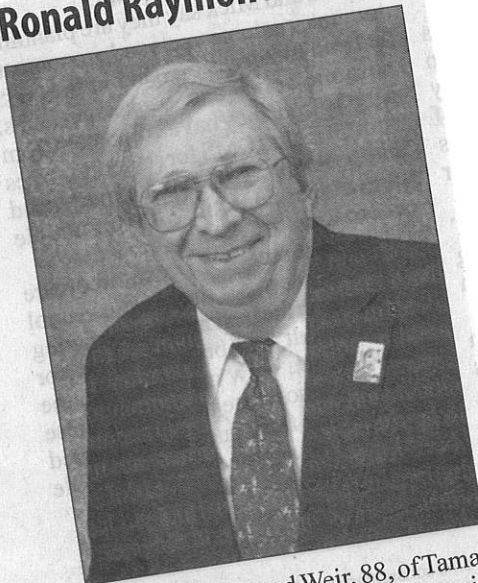


Ronald Raymond Weir



Ronald Raymond Weir, 88, of Tama, died at Sunny Hill Care Center in Tama, on Wednesday, April 6, 2022. A private interment will be held at Oak Hill Cemetery.
