Beverly was born April 18, 1928 to Arthur C. and Neva (Boyd) Goeke in Orion, IL.

After her children grew up, she worked at Montezuma Mini Mart, later to become Depot Express, for over 15 years. It was here that she came in contact with many members of the Montezuma community outside of her circle of relatives. When she was 65 years old, she retired.
