Alice Lofgreen, 90, of the Glenwood Place in Marshalltown, formerly of Montezuma and the Bobcat Estates in Marshalltown, died early Saturday morning, March 31, at the Glenwood Place while in care

of the Iowa Hospice.

Her funeral service and a celebration of her life was held Monday, April 2, at the Mitchell Family Funeral Home with a time of fellowship and refreshments immediately following. Interment rites were held at the Jackson Township Cemetery, Montezuma.

Born Alice Kingery on April 4, 1916, at Eldon, she was one of three daughters born to Oran and Mina (Riegel) Kingery. She moved to Ottumwa with her family in 1918 and attended school there. In 1931 the family moved to Montezuma where she graduated from high school in 1934. Alice graduated from Drake University in 1936 and taught first grade

at Moorhead. On Oct. 24, 1937, she was united in marriage to Harold Lofgreen. They resided in Jefferson one year and then moved to Montezuma. Alice was a member of Delta Gamma Sorority, taught Sunday school, substitute taught, and was a member of the Ken Club, H.G. Club and the American Legion Auxiliary, a charter member of the Women's Society, Christian Women and the Montezuma Methodist Church. She transferred to the Marshalltown United Methodist Church when they moved to Marshalltown in 1983 from Lake Ponderosa where they had lived the previous 14 years. Alice enjoyed crossword puzzles, reading and being with family.

Surviving are her daughter, Sara "Sally" (Larry) Hansen of Marshalltown, son Harold "Hal" (Connie) of Becker, Minn.; grandchildren Jennifer Roe, Dr. Beth (Andy) Kilborn and Jim Lofgreen as well as her family at Glenwood Place.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Harold and two sisters.
