
Betty Roof 8-3-2023

Following her education, Betty moved to Des Moines to work at the Des Moines Register and Tribune. She returned to Montezuma and began working at her parent's restaurant, Joe's Cafe in Montezuma.

She met Donald Howard Roof of Grinnell and they were united in marriage on June 4, 1961, at the Montezuma United Methodist Church. They raised their family in Grinnell and Malcom.

Betty was a child care provider and later was employed at Grinnell College in the Food Service Division for seven years.
