
Donald Fredrick Nicklas

The last few years Don has enjoyed watching his grandchildren's sporting events and always tried to make it to their ball games. He spent time at local businesses catching up on the day's news and sharing coffee with community members in the last few years.

Catholic Church of Brooklyn.
