
Suzanne Hansen



Suzanne Hansen, 78, of Grinnell, died on Monday, November 4, 2024, surrounded by family, at St. Francis Manor in Grinnell.

Suzi was well-known for her generosity, whether that was including a little extra baked good to a customer's order, or faithfully recognizing birthdays, anniversaries, and other special occasions with gifts and cards
