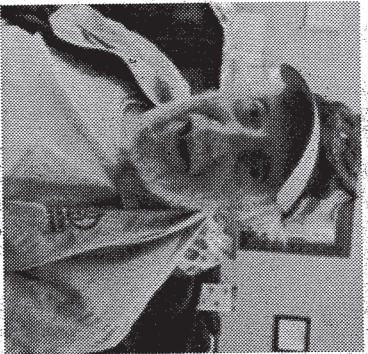


Kenneth Edward Duncan
