Marvin Baumfalk, 70, of rural Beattie, Kan., formerly of Grinnell, died Saturday, May 10, 2008, at his residence.

A funeral service will be held Saturday, May 17, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Beatrice, Neb., with interment following in Evergreen Cemetery, Beatrice. Designation will be made later for a memorial fund which has been established at Kinsley Mortuary, 1006 Broadway, Marysville, Kan.
