Linda Lee Bever, 52, and Dale Emmett Beaver, 45, of Hutchinson, Kan., died of an accident Sunday, Aug. 3, at Cheney Reservoir in Hutchinson.

A funeral service took place Friday, Aug. 8, at The Father's House in Hutchinson with Pastor Allen Smith officiating. Burial was in Memorial Park Cemetery.
