## **Robert E. Neighbors**

Robert E. Neighbors, 81, of Emmetsburg, formerly of Grinnell, died Friday, June 27, 2008, at Palo Alto County Hospital in Emmetsburg.

A funeral service was held Monday, June 30, in St. Paul Lutheran Church in Emmetsburg with the Rev. Dennis Angland officiating. Inumment followed in Evergreen Cemetery in Emmetsburg.

He was a member of the city's planning and zoning commission and a member of the board for Kathleen's Residential Care Facility. He enjoyed sports including baseball, basketball and golf, and was an avid reader.

He is survived by his wife Lois of Emmetsburg; his daughters and son, Dr. Linda Landon of Jefferson City, Mo., Andrea Masek of Bellevue, Neb. and Steven Neighbors of Boston, Mass; five grandchildren and one brother Terry Neighbors.
