Mrs. Emily W. Agnew, 82, the widow of Francis (Frank) Agnew of west Sixth Ave., Grinnell, died early Tuesday morning at Friendship Manor. She had been in failing health.

The daughter of Samuel and Bridget Farrell Watson, she was born Feb. 14, 1891, near Ewart. She attended the rural schools near her family home. On Oct. 8, 1919, she was married to Francis Agnew.

Mr. and Mrs. Agnew had farmed near Ewart until 1957 when they moved to Grinnell. Following her husband's death Dec. 4, 1963, Mrs. Agnew continued to make her home on west Sixth Ave.

She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Altar and Rosary Society.

Mrs. Agnew was preceded in death by her husband; three brothers, James, Tom, and William Watson; and a sister, Mrs. Ellarena Sheehy. Survivors include two brothers, Harry O. Watson of Sioux City and Clermont Watson of Sarasota, Fla.; a sister, Elizabeth Watson of Grinnell; and eight nieces and nephews.

The Mass of the Resurrection for Mrs. Agnew will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Mary's Catholic Church, with the Rev. Leo V. Kuebrich officiating. Organist will be John W. Penne. Pallbearers will be O. H. Black, Francis Comerford, Leo Devereux, Don Donohoe, Leonard Heinzelman, and Michael Hotchkin.
