Robert, son of David and Sarah Agnew, was born in Campbellford, Ontario, Canada, on June 23, 1879, and departed this life, April 15, 1953, in Grinnell, at the age of 73 years, 9 months and 8 days. In 1899, he came with his parents and engaged in farming near Ewart.
