Sarah Patterson Agnew was born sixty years ago in the county of Armagh, Ireland, and departed this life Jan. 12, 1911.

She came to America in 1868, arriving in New York. In 1874 she married David Agnew in Dutchess county, New York. Afterward they went to Canada and from Canada to Michigan where they resided eight years. For the past eleven years they have resided near Ewart, Iowa.

To this union eight children were born: five boys and three girls. One daughter, Susan, preceded her to the other world. The husband and the remaining children were all at her bedside in the last hour. The last sickness was very brief, being of only two days' duration, although for many months previous she had not been strong.

She united with the Presbyterian church in Canada many years ago, and lately she united with the United Presbyterian church of Ewart.

Besides her bereaved husband and children she leaves a wide circle of sorrowing friends. Her Christian faith was strong at the last hour and she seemed ready and anxious to go to her loved ones beyond.

The funeral services were held in the Unitd Presbyterian church of Ewart and were conducted by her pastor, Rev. S. M. Hood, assisted by Rev. Rankin, of Ewart, and Rev. W. W. Woodburn, of Grinnell. The remains were laid to rest in Clover Hill Cemetery.
