Daniel Wayne Akery, 18, of Brooklyn died Tuesday, March 30, in Brooklyn.

His body was discovered outside a home at 318 W. Des Moines St. Authorities have tentatively ruled the death a suicide.

Funeral services will be conducted at 9:30 a.m. Friday at Grace United Methodist Church in Brooklyn, with the Rev. James B. Rea Jr., pastor of the First Presbyterian Church of Brooklyn, officiating. Burial will be in Brooklyn Cemetery, with the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

He was the son of Pat and Jacqueline Duncan Akery and was born Aug. 10, 1974, in Muscatine. He had been a resident of Brooklyn since 1975 and was a senior at BGM High School at the time of his death. He had participated in wrestling at the high school.

Surviving are his parents; one brother, Scott of Brooklyn; a sister, Carrie of Houston, Texas; and his grandparents, Clifford and Barbara Duncan of Grinnell and Verna Akery of Brooklyn. He was preceded in death by his grandfather.

A memorial fund has been established.
