Jennie served as clerk in the State Legislature for 12 sessions and worked in the state auditors office for six years. She was a court reporter for 12 years.

After the death of her sister, Susie, in 1940, she came home and kept house for her brother. She was a member of the Methodist Church and a charter member of the Grange. She was Midway preceded in death by her parents, four brothers, and four sisters.
