Henry Andersen, 76, of Kellogg died of heart failure Tuesday, Jan. 21, at Skiff Medical Center in Newton.

Funeral services were conducted Friday at Reese Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Jerry Doellinger of Our Savior Lutheran Church officiating. Military graveside rites were conducted by the Veterans of Foreign Wars, with burial in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg.
