A. P. Anderson was born near the central part of Sweden on December 10th, 1848. His early life was spent in Sweden. He removed to this country in 1871, working for a number of years as a farm hand.

Later he farmed for himself and bought a farm in the northern part of Malcom township, where he remained until six years ago, when he bought property in Grinnell where he resided until his death, which occurred on Friday morning, May 12th, 1911. He was aged 62 years, 5 months and 2 days.

On January 25th, 1881, he was married to Lizzie Shaffer. To this union four children were born, two daughters and two sons.

The two daughters, Elsie, and Mrs. Anna Ohland, passed away before him.

This leaves to mourn his death, his wife, two sons, Glenn and Fred, and two grandchildren, Gladys and Grant Ohland; also three brothers, J. A. Anderson, of Grinnell, C. J. Anderson, and F. A. Anderson, of Joliet, Ill., and four sisters, Mrs. Louisa Conlin, of Chicago, Ill., and Lotta, Hanna and Hattie, both in Sweden.

He was an honest, upright and industrious man, a kind father and a loving husband. He will be missed by his family and a host of friends of this vicinity, where he spent most of his life, an honored citizen among his fellow men.
