Mr. Anderson rites are held

Eldon M. "Andy" Anderson, 70, Waukee, formerly of Grinnell, died Dec. 9 at Mercy Medical Center, Des Moines, of congestive heart failure.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Dec. 12, at McLaren's Funeral Home, West Des Moines, with Pastor James Carstensen, Immanuel Lutheran Church, Waukee, officiating. Interment was in Resthaven Cemetery, West Des Moines.
