

## Phera Angell dies in Osage

Phera Angell, 89, of Osage, formerly of Grinnell, died Wednesday, Aug. 22, at an Osage nursing home.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Champion Funeral Home in Osage, with the Rev. John Gilbert officiating. Burial was in the Osage Cemetery.

Miss Angell was born Sept. 4, 1904, in Burr Oak Township, Mitchell County. She attended rural schools and Osage High School, later studying music at Cedar Valley Seminary in Osage. She also attended business college in Mankato, Minn., and worked as a legal secretary.

After retiring as a legal secretary for a judge in Ames, she worked at the Poweshiek County National Bank here. She lived at the Mayflower Home until 1981 when she moved to the Osage nursing home to be close to her family.
