Everett Armstrong, 83, of Grinnell died Wednesday, Sept. 6, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

A memorial service was conducted Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Del Dawes, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner, and honorary bearers were Dr. John DeMeulenaere, Al Eisenman, Dr. H.R. Light, Chuck Manly, Milt Maupin and Ned Postels.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery.

He was the son of Foster Lewis and Lillian Carlstrom Armstrong and was born Jan. 3, 1917. He was a lifelong resident of Grinnell.

He was a 1935 graduate of Grinnell High School. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in March 1941 and served with an evacuation hospital in North Africa and the European Theater during World War II. He received the Legion of Merit medal. Mr. Armstrong returned to Grinnell in July 1945.

He was married to Phyllis Colton Feb. 23, 1946, in Little Rock, Ark. He founded Armstrong Electric, Inc., in Grinnell and served as president until his retirement in 1980.

He was a member of the Grinnell City Council from 1949 to 1951 and was a life member and past exalted ruler of the Elks Lodge here. He also was a member of the Grinnell United Methodist Church.

Surviving are his wife; one daughter, Linda Robbins of Lenexa, Kan.; one son, Phillip of Washington, D.C.; and two grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Harry; and one sister, Margaret Haunsperger.
