

Earl S. Asp rites Friday ^{6/6}_{12/1}

Earl S. Asp, 64, of Gilman died suddenly Tuesday evening of an apparent heart attack in Tama.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Gilman Community Church, with burial at Rose Hill Memorial Gardens, Marshalltown. The Smith Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

The son of William and Sophia Larson Asp, he was born Jan. 29, 1913, in Polk County, Wis. He attended schools near his home.
