

## Rhee Auman <sup>72</sup> Services Today <sup>68</sup>

Rhee H. Auman, 72, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday morning at his home in Cedar Falls, Ia. He was born on Feb. 4, 1896, at Mifflintown, Pa., and was a veteran of World War I.
