Services Held For Giles Awtry

Lynnville (Special) — Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Saturday in the Morgan-Loehr Funeral Home in Newton for Giles Awtry, who died April 6 in the Mahaska Hospital at the age of 68.

Mr. Awtry lived in the Galesburg area from his birth until 1941 when he and his family moved to their present home on their farm between Lynnville and Searsboro.

Survivors include his wife and four children; a sister — Mrs. Margaret Awtry Slycord; and a brother — Charles Awtry, both of Galesburg, Iowa.

He was preceded in death by his parents; a sister, Ruby Michmershuizen; and a brother, Harry Awtry.
