Frank Baarda, longtime resident of the Lynnville area, passed away in his home in Lynnville on Aug. 18, 1966, at the age of 57 years, 11 months and 22 days.

Frank Baarda, the son of John and Sarah Dunnick Baarda, was born at Maizie, Okla., on Aug. 26, 1908, and came with his parents to Iowa at an early age. He received his education in the Rock Creek Township elementary schools and he served in the armed forces during World War II.

On June 15, 1937, he was united in marriage with Elsie DeRuiter at Sully, Iowa. He had been employed in different types of work during his life and was custodian of the Lynnville Friends church for the past seven years.

He is survived by his widow, Elsie, and his two children, Harold Dwayne and Betty Jean, both living at home; one brother, Fred Baarda of Monroe; one sister, Mrs. Floyd (Louise) VanderZyl of Pella; two nieces and two nephews, and other relatives and a host of friends.

Funeral services were held in the Lynnville Friends church on Saturday, Aug. 20, at 2 p.m., in charge of Rev. Peter Schuler. Mrs. Howard Macy accompanied Mrs. Doyle Schultz who sang "Abide With Me" and "Beyond the Sunset." Casket bearers were Dale Baarda, Eldon VanderZyl, Arnold DeRuiter, Roger Schultz, Paul DeJong and Henry Zuidema.
