

DEATH OF NEWBURG CITIZEN.

A. F. Badger Is Claimed by Dread
Pneumonia Saturday — Body
Taken to Missouri.

A. F. Badger died Saturday, November 23, at his home in Newburg from pneumonia resulting from the flu. Mr. Badger was a native of Missouri, being born in that state April 20, 1880. He is survived by his wife and three small children.

He had lived in Newburg only a year, during which time he was employed in the Farmers' Elevator of that city.

The body was taken Monday evening to Glenwood Junction, Missouri, for interment.
