Audrey Bailey, 98, of Grinnell died Tuesday, Feb. 16, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Friday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond Lott of the Grinnell United Methodist Church officiating. Organist will be Margaret Wheeler. Burial will be in the Bethel Cemetery.
