

Robert Bailey dies in mishap

Robert Weldon Bailey, 19, of Rawlins, Wyo., formerly of Grinnell, was killed Saturday night, March 28, in an automobile accident at Rawlins.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Wilkinson-Hatch Funeral Home, with the Rev. J. Allen Goss officiating. Burial was at Oakwood Cemetery, Waco, Tex.

He was born July 30, 1961, in Houston and was a graduate of Central High School, San Angelo, Tex. He attended Texas Tech at Lubbock and was employed by Monsanto Chemical Co. in Rawlins at the time of his death. He was a member of the United Methodist Church.

Survivors include his mother, Beth Goodman Bailey of San Angelo, a former learning disabilities teacher at Grinnell Junior High School; his father, Joe W. Bailey Jr. of Waco, formerly with General Telephone Co.; a twin brother, Joseph Lee Bailey of Waco; his maternal grandmother, Mrs. E.C. Goodman of Bellmead, Tex.; his paternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Joe W. Bailey of Tyler, Tex.; a step-sister, Emily Weirback of Waco; and a step-brother, Ted Wierback, also of Waco.
