

Stella Bailey rites today

Stella F. Bailey, 79, of Rte. 2, Grinnell, died of an apparent heart attack at her home Wednesday morning, Sept. 16.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with burial at Hazelwood Cemetery. Memorials in Mrs. Bailey's name may be made to the Westfield Community Church and left at the funeral home.

The daughter of Lars and Hannah Jenson Hanson, she was born on Dec. 3, 1901, in Jasper County. She attended rural schools and was graduated from Grinnell High School. She taught for a number of years in rural schools in Jasper and Poweshiek counties.

On Nov. 27, 1925, she was married to Warren E. Bailey at Jessup. The couple had three children. Mr. and Mrs. Bailey had farmed southeast of Grinnell and in the Brooklyn and Kellogg areas before moving to Grinnell in 1942. Mrs. Bailey was a member of the V.F.W. Auxiliary and the World War I Veterans Auxiliary. She was also a member of the ladies society of the Westfield Church.

Survivors include her three children, Warren E. Bailey of Chicago, Ill., Roger D. Bailey of Grinnell, and Donna Billman of Phoenix, Ariz.; eight grandchildren; and one great-grandson. She was preceded in death by her husband; one grandson; two brothers, Harold and Arthur Hanson; and four sisters, Carrie Violet Vinall, Birdie Anderson, Edythe H. Brooke and Edith Hanson.
