—Word has been received here of the death of Thomas T. Baker a graduate of Iowa College in the class of 1874. Mr. Baker died at his home in Butte, Mont., of erysipelas at 66 years of age. He was a surveyor and was one of the pioneers in this work in the far west. Mr. Baker came to Lynnvillle from his home in West Virginia after four years' service in the Union army and was quite old when he graduated from Iowa College. After teaching two years here in the academy he went to Montana where he became a very successful railroad engineer. His brother, Dr. A. J. Baker, I. C. '81, was drowned a few years ago.
