Warren C. Baker, 72, Rte. 2, Grinnell, died Wednesday morning, March 14, of cancer at the West Texas Medical Center in Abilene, Texas.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Ben See of Abilene officiating. Burial will be at Westfield Cemetery. Friends may call at the Smith Funeral Home beginning Friday afternoon.
