

## Rites held for Fred Baldwin

Fred L. Baldwin, 96, of Newton, formerly of rural Kellogg, died of leukemia June 15 at his home.

Funeral services were conducted at 10 a.m. Wednesday at the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with burial in Our Silent City Cemetery, Kellogg. Memorials in Mr. Baldwin's name may be made to the Kellogg Historical Society or Progress Industries.
