

OBITUARY.

Hannah Cain was born in Ohio, county of Coshocton, May 29, 1822, and died in Grinnell, March 7th, 1905 in the 83rd year of her age. On July 1st, 1841 she was married to Hezekiah Barr, in Ohio. In 1856 they moved with their family to Princeton, Ill., at which place Mr. Barr died in 1871. A few years after her husband's death Mrs. Barr moved to Grinnell and since 1877 has made her home with her son, John. She was the mother of eight children, 2 boys and 6 girls two of whom survive her; a daughter, Mrs. Jennie Eager, living in Omaha, Neb., and her son, John Barr of Grinnell. While a young woman Mrs. Barr united with the Christian church and for many years her husband was an honored deacon of that same church. She was a woman of strong constitution but for the past three years, on account of injuries, has been the most of the time confined to her bed.

For a long time she has hopefully waited the call of her Master; death had no terrors for her and after she had said to her pastor, "I'm waiting for the dear Lord to come." Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord for they rest from their labors and their works do follow them.

The funeral services occurred at the home on south Broad Street at 2 o'clock on Thursday afternoon, March 9, conducted by Rev. S. Rowland Robinson of the Baptist church. \*
