Rites Tuesday For Nettie Bayley, Retired Teacher

A prominent elementary school teacher here and lifetime Grinnell resident, Miss Nettie Bayley, 82, died Saturday morning at a local hospital following a stroke suffered five days earlier.

Services are to be held from the Smith Funeral Home at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday with Dr. G. S. Bruland, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating. Organ music will be provided by Mrs. Esther Auman.

Serving as pallbearers will be Harold Harris, John Hotenkin, Sam Neff, Crott Pilgrim, Howard Pohlman, and Max Smith. Interment will be in Hazelwood cemetery.

Miss Bayley was the daughter of Jacob and Rhonda Faulkes Bayley and was born June 17th, 1878 at Grinnell. She attended the local public schools and graduated from Grinnell high school and Grinnell college.

She will be remembered by many as their grade school teacher in the Grinnell school system as she taught for 50 years before retiring. She was principal of Parker school for many of those years.

Miss Bayley was a member of the Grinnell Methodist church and the W.S.C.S.

Bequests Made In Will Of Late Nettie Bayley

Will of Nettie Bayley, former Grinnell school teacher who died Apr. 22nd at the age of 82, has been filed with the office of Poweshiek county Clerk of Court Gladys Gabriel.

Several bequests are included in the will, although no inventory of the estate has yet been made.

The will stipulates that all household goods and personal effects go to Iona Halterman of Grinnell. It further orders that all property be converted to cash with \$1,000 to go to the Grinnell Methodist church; \$500 to brother, Thomas Bayley of Tenkelman, Nebr.; and the remainder to the Iowa Methodist hospital in Des Moines to be used for the Blank Memorial hospital.
