

Maude Beaty services set 12/15/74

Maude Ellen Beaty, 86, of Marshalltown, a former Newburg resident, died Sunday morning, Dec. 15, at the

Westwood Nursing Home in Marshalltown.

The daughter of Oliver and Mary Mankey, she was born April 1, 1888, in Newburg. She attended the Newburg Public Schools. On June 17, 1914, she was married to Frank L. Beaty in Newburg. The couple had one son, Burneil G. Beaty.

After their marriage, the couple made their home in Newburg. Mr. Beaty died on Nov. 24, 1918. Mrs. Beaty continued to live in Newburg, where she operated the telephone switchboard for the town in her home. She moved to Marshalltown in 1938, and then to Mason City in 1943, where she lived until 1964. She was employed by the Park Hospital in Mason City.

B. Beaty, and her great-grandson, John Allen Beaty, all of Marshalltown; and several nieces, nephews, and cousins. She was preceded in death by her husband Frank; her grandson, William Leslie Beaty, who died in infancy; her parents; her step-father, P.S.
