## **Bill Behrens Dies at 87**

William Dietrich Behrens was born Nov. 20, 1878 in Dayton twp., Iowa county. His parents were Henry and Anna Bahrens. He was baptized and confirmed in St. John's Lutheran, Lincoln twp., where he was a life - long member. In this congregation he held offices of elder and chairman.
